# Dustin Rislov Benefit

A sudden seizure followed by a diagnosis of brain cancer is not what you'd expect in a previously very healthy 33 year old, married, father of three young boys.

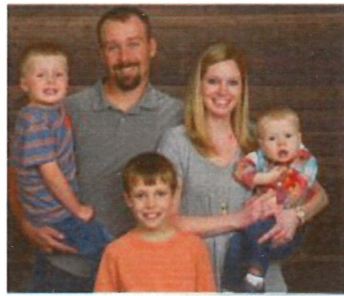
Dustin was admitted to the hospital and placed on anti-seizure and steroid medications. The following morning a MRI was performed and they were given an initial diagnosis the tumor was a primary glial neoplasm.

Surgery to remove the tumor was on February 1st. During his 10 plus hour surgery, the surgeons were able to remove a little over 90% of the tumor without causing Dustin any loss of function or side effects.

Following surgery, pathology determined Dustin's tumor was a Grade 3 Anaplastic (malignant) Astrocytoma, brain cancer.

He started a six week treatment of daily proton beam radiation, along with chemotherapy, on February 26th. He will have radiation treatments five days a week in Rochester and chemotherapy daily for 6 weeks with 1 month off and 6 months of chemotherapy treatment.

Both Dustin and Ashley are fortunate in having good jobs and health insurance coverage. But insurance does not cover all the expenses -- deductibles, co-pays, loss of income from their jobs, and daily travel to Rochester.



Dustin is a journeyman electrician and not able to work due to the seizure risk and inability to drive. Ashley is a radiologic technician and is also unable to work because of her need to take care of the boys, ages 9, 5, and 19 months, and Dustin. She also has to drive him to Rochester daily for his many appointments and treatments.
