This person will be responsible for the classroom preparation, instruction, and evaluation of student learning for 16 credits of courses/per semester in the Construction Electrician program. Instruction is delivered in the classroom. Candidates may also engage in such activities as student advising, committee assignments, classroom research and community service as part of the overall work assignment on a proportional basis. Candidate should possess good communication, listening, and human relations skills.
